Senator Walter A. Stosch has represented his constituents in the General Assembly for over 20 years, establishing a long and distinguished career in Virginia politics and the community. From 1983 to 1991 he was a member of the Virginia House of Delegates, serving on the House Committees on Finance, Education and Claim, and Conservation and Natural Resources. In 1992 he was elected to the Virginia Senate, serving as the Senate Majority Leader from 1998-2008, and currently as Republican Leader Emeritus. While serving in the General Assembly, Senator Stosch has been responsible for landmark legislation that has improved the lives of Virginians. He has authored laws that cut taxes, strengthened public schools, cracked down on crime, and created thousands of new jobs in the Richmond area.

Senator Stosch not only is recognized for his commitment and service to Virginia politics but also for his outstanding community and professional service. He has served both as president and member of the Virginia Society of Certified Public Accountants and the Estate Planning Council; and is a past member of the adjunct faculties of the University of Richmond and Virginia Commonwealth University. Senator Stosch is committed to the best interests of the Commonwealth and continues to be one of the most respected and effective legislators.
