Our Mid-Year Stats

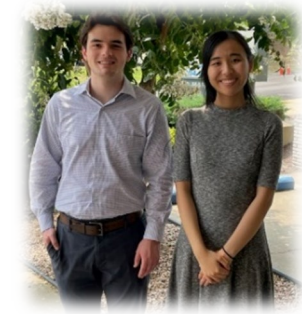
We've been busy! We are happy to share our stats for the first half of 2023:

-  384 taxpayers represented in income tax controversy cases
-  224 cases involved more than one tax year
-  88 cases involved representation of ESL taxpayers
-  123 cases included a state tax issue
-  \$155,187.82 dollars refunded in cash to taxpayers
-  32 total outreach activities to low income & ESL taxpayers and other service providers
-  26 educational presentations to 1,452 total attendees
-  245 one-one consultations to low income and/or ESL taxpayers
-  212 hours of service provided by volunteers
-  \$151, 497.05 reduction in tax liabilities, penalties, and interest
